

SA bids farewell to Vuyo Mbuli

Today is the saddest day in the media as South Africans bid farewell to veteran journalist and commentator Vuyo Mbuli.

Mbuli, who presented Morning Live on SABC 2, passed away last week Saturday at Bloemfontein Medi-Clinic. The SABC reported that the 46-year-old, collapsed while watching a rugby match between the Cheetahs and the Reds at the Free State Stadium on Saturday night.

He was treated at the scene before being rushed to the Medi-Clinic hospital in Bloemfontein, where he later died. The broadcaster reported that Mbuli died of a pulmonary embolism. It reported

that this was the outcome of a post mortem conducted on Monday. Previous reports that Mbuli suffered a heart attack were untrue, family spokeswoman Rowena Baird told the SABC on Tuesday. "His blood had clotted and he had two relatively large clots," she told the broadcaster.

"The clots tend to move around the body, and they moved to his chest, hence he complained of chest pains," disclosed Baird. Indeed the nation has lost the most cheerful and encouraging man who stood by what he believed in. Many have described him as a man who was always committed to creating a platform for discussion and debate on difficult human rights issues facing the country. He kept South Africans glued to their

screens for almost nine years. It is no doubt that the show will never be the same again.

On Monday his co-presenter, Leanne Manas, could not hold her tears as she presented the show. Archbishop Desmond Tutu, who is in London, paid tribute to Mbuli and was quoted saying, "With gentle and genteel style, perfectly suited to morning television and radio, his was for many people the first and most trusted analysis of the daily news," said in a statement.

Mbuli has indeed left a legacy of journalistic integrity that established him as a legend of the media industry. His funeral will be held today at St. Johns College, Houghton at 9am. Rest in Peace, Sharp! Sharp!

Chris Brown involved in car crash

Los Angeles - Chris Brown has been involved in a car crash.

The 24-year-old singer and his ex-girlfriend Karrueche Tran were involved in a collision on Tuesday when the bad boy rapper shunted his white Range Rover into a black Mercedes at a set of traffic lights in Beverly Hills, California.

The Fine China hitmaker - who was en route to a recording studio with his former lover - immediately got out of his vehicle after the smash and exchanged insurance details with the female driver, whilst Karrueche took photos of the impact.

Nobody was injured in the accident and police were not called to the scene.

It is not the first time Chris has had car trouble.

In February, Chris wrecked his Porsche 911 after he hurtled into a wall claiming he was cut off by "aggressive" paparazzi photographers in

Los Angeles, California.


A spokesperson at the time said: "The occupants jumped out, with cameras, and aggressively approached his vehicle.

In an effort to remove himself from the situation, he [Chris] began to back down an alley at which point his was cut off by two additional vehicles.

"Chris' vehicle was totalled due to this aggressive pursuit by the paparazzi."

Chris - who has reportedly reunited with model Karrueche - recently ended his turbulent relationship with Rihanna after deciding to go "solo".

Announcing the bitter split with the Stay hitmaker - who he calls Shawty - he said: "I'm gonna do it solo. At the end of the day Shawty doing her own thing, she on the road. It's always gonna be love. I'm a grown man, just gotta fast forward." - *BangShowBiz*
